

## **PMC NEWS LETTER FOR NOV – DEC 2017**

**Donors, Friends and Partners**

### **REF: APPRECIATION FROM THE PENTECOSTAL MISSIONARY CHURCH (PMC) TANZANIA**

Sincere greetings in the Lord Jesus Christ

It is my pleasure to convey to you all, on behalf of the Missionary Board and the National Leadership of the Pentecostal Missionary Church, may I take this opportunity to thank you for your intercessory prayers and material support financially for the whole of the year 2017.

It has been a year filled with challenges in our ministry. Without your prayers and financial support it would have been extremely difficult to achieve our development goals as follows:-

- (1) Purchase of our plot and the construction of the new church building for the Headquarters. This followed the demolition of our former church and offices godown for storage of books and other donated humanitarian goods, power house (prayer cells) and classrooms for the School of Ministry. Also the Senior Pastor's office and eleven rooms which were rented (shops) to the business community. The church was able to receive income through rental fees.

However, your moral and material support enabled us to complete the sanctuary building which is quite big and modern.

Thank you very much, may God remember you in Kingdom and open doors for you further.

- (2) We managed to hold Gospel campaign crusades and conferences which realized a big number of souls to be saved, receive deliverance and were blessed.

- (3) We drilled deep well water for the rural people so that they could enjoy the provision of clean and safe water. This eliminated epidemic diseases like diarrhea, typhoid and cholera.
- (4) We cared for and educated orphans at Vocational Training schools, Tailoring, Teacher Training colleges; in secretarial services etc. they are already did their final examinations on Diploma level.
- (5) Insisted our churches upcoming and ministered in the following regions:
- Mbeya, Chunya, Malila and Songwe Valley
  - Morogoro, Chamwino (Dodoma)
  - Mwanza – Kisesa and other City Surburbs in which we planted 3 new Churches.
  - Singida
  - Manyara
  - Njombe
  - Kagera
  - Coast region
  - Dodoma
- (6) We received one container with Gospel Materials and goods for the disabled people and humanitarian for free distribution

## **EXPECTATIONS-2018**

- a) We hope to continue the building of the godown for the Literature Ministry.
- b) We expected also to build the Pastors' offices and one for the Bishop.
- c) We hope to make a Bible Reading Marathon for ten (10) days from 27 December 2017 through to January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018. It is expected that this event will attract many people as the whole Bible will be read, verse by verse, person after another. It is anticipated that we will use ninety (90) hours to complete (Genesis – Revelation). Our hope is also to witness people's lives changed, Souls saved and some are delivered, as we continue the Bible reading plan. The Bible Reading Marathon Fire Conference starts on 03 January 2018 to 14 January 2018

## **FINANCIAL NEED**

From January 2018, our financial needs are mainly directed to meet the following:-

**1. CONSTRUCTION WORKS.**

- Costs of construction of classrooms for the Vocational Skills training centre and the school of Ministry (Bible School).
- Costs of construction of hostels for the statements for both the Bible School (School of Ministry) and the Vocational Skills Training Centre. Pastor's and Bishop's offices.

Basically we have to meet cost for purchase of building materials amounting 14, 328.767 (usd). Artisans and masonry work will be carried out by technicians from Netherlands (Holland) through GAIN INTERNATIONAL, an organization that will provide volunteers for the project. This is to request the Churches in America and elsewhere to help us raise the funds required, quoted above (usd 14, 328, 767) You can donate any amount as the Lord leads.

**2. Tools with A Mission (UK) will provide us with equipment for all the trades like:-**

- Carpentry and joinery
- Tailoring and embroidery
- Secretarial services
- Auto mechanics
- Plumbing
- Masonry etc

They have requested us to meet the shipment costs of usd 1, 820.

**3. LOVE PACKAGES** have agreed to send to our Ministry containers with Bibles and other Christian Literature, Theological and Doctrinal books which will help Ministers to grow in the faith. An agreement is, they meet costs up to the destination port and we meet 20 clearing costs amounting to usd 2,450 for 20 ft container.

**4. We are expecting to hold GREAT GOSPEL CRUSADES** quarterly (every three months) which will be followed by inner seminars for new converts.

5. The school of Ministry will resume running for new students in January 2018

### **KANGAZA ORPHANAGE CENTRE IN BUKOBA, KAGERA REGION**

This orphanage centre is facing many problems financially. The buildings (new dormitories) have not been completed, food supplies and education expenses. This centre lacks permanent supporters/donors which renders serious difficulty in operating it.

A certain youth started the project, being helped by some American people. It has forty five (45) orphans' children at the camp, with another 40 who live in their homes. Despite the fact the centre is registered legally, it is facing challenges which need the donor community to consider helping there be someone /organization with a heart for suffering children, please connect him to me. The American is now no longer supporting the centre.

The major needs are for:

- Renovation of the buildings, and completion.
- To be provided with used/new beds and mattresses
- To be supplied with clothes and school uniforms, shoes, reading materials, stationeries etc
- Food supplies and sundries
- Day to day operational costs.

Their budget stands at USD 35,000 which is urgently needed to have the children surviving – who are 100% orphan with both parents dead, due to HIV/AIDS pandemic, which is widespread in Kagera Region, the worst, affected place in Tanzania. I visited Orphans Children Home recently, I gave them gift for Christmas Celebration and they were very happy as you can see in the photograph.
