



THE PMC NEWS LETTER FOR OCTOBER THROUGH DECEMBER 2018

Dear friends and co-workers in the Lord,

Receive my sincere heartfelt greetings, those of my family and the church of God at Kibaha (PMC).

First, may I take this opportunity to express appreciation for your past moral and material assistance. By your financial help we managed to build our church, purchase church furniture, and conduct several ministries such as:



- The school of Ministry
- The literature Evangelism ministry, and
- Supporting the Orphans and vulnerable children in and around Kibaha Town, as well as Bukoba (Kagera region in western Tanzania).

The PMC headquarters church located in Kibaha is fast growing both numerically (membership increasing), and in their spiritual dimension *in the knowledge of God and the crucified Christ, abiding in His strength according to his glorious power, unto all patience and long suffering with joy.* (Col.1:11).

Indeed, may the God bless you for co-partnering in the work of God in Tanzania (East Africa) through your prayer support and donation of finances.

However, we strategize and plan to becoming a self-supporting church by having income-generating activities like tailoring, carpentry and provision of secretarial and other computer services. In the year 2019, we intend to do the following projects;

- Construction of classrooms for the Bible School and School of Ministry.
- Build the orphanage center where Orphans and Vulnerable children will be accommodated/cared for,
- A hostel with modern facilities to cater for the need of our visiting local and foreign guests,
- Construction of ministers' offices, (Pastors, evangelists, teachers, etc.) All these are estimated to cost a total of \$21,000.

II. WALL FENCE

We also need to fence the church plot to increase security, and eliminate the possibility of intruders leading to land conflict.

A wall fence around the plot is expected to cost \$3000.

III. CHURCH MUSIC PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM.

Currently we depend on hired/rented equipment. However, we plan to buy a PA system and request\$15,000



IV. PLASTIC CHAIRS

Through preaching at crusade grounds, house-to-house witnessing, person-to-person follow up, the number of Christians has been increasing weekly. The miracles and healings that confirm the Word preached have brought many people to the Lord, as they are urged to accept God's purpose for their lives. The more we minister, the more people believe and join our church. Consequently, we need 200 more plastic chairs @\$7 =\$1400.

V. TRANSPORT.

Klbaaha is the headquarters of our church and operates the Gospel Literature Distribution center. (Literature Evangelism). We need to distribute Christian books, Bibles, tracts, Sunday school materials etc to churches, schools and colleges. We also serve libraries, and the public, hospitals, health centers dispensaries and prisons.

We receive donated humanitarian goods like walk-sticks for the blind, crutches and wheel chairs for the crippled. These have to be distributed to the needy.

Purchasing a Hiace delivery van/bus would help us in the process of distribution of the Christian literature and the humanitarian goods mentioned.

It would additionally transport our foreign visitors to view our wildlife in the tourist attraction areas-game parks, national parks etc. It is estimated to cost \$18,000.

VI. KANGAZA CHILDREN HOME IN BUKOBA

Throughout this year I have written frequently on this home for the orphans and vulnerable children, who are victims of the HIV/AIDS pandemic which claimed the lives of their parents. The buildings need major renovations. Also there are no beds and mattresses. Clothing and uniforms are insufficient for the 50 OVC who stay at the orphanage center, while 45 receive home-based care, assistance and provisions for daily needs.

Currently we do not have consistently and regular donors. So we call upon all who have a heart for the OVC to donate for the their daily needs. The yearly requirement is approximately \$35,000.

VII. CLEARANCE OF CONTAINERS AT DAR ES SALAAM PORT

We have communication with friendly donors who want to send us containers with Christian literature, Bibles, tracts, and other Gospel materials, and humanitarian aid materials for the distribution to the disabled people. They are ready and willing to pay the cost, insurance and freight to the Dar es Salaam port.

However, we are to bear the port clearance charges, as well as other port related charges, and Inland Transport Charges from Dar es Salaam port to Kibaha. It costs \$3000 per container. For the year 2019, we expect 8 containers from them = \$24,000.

VIII. GOSPEL CAMPAIGN CRUSADES

After building the new sanctuary, following the demolition of the previous church building, to give way to the construction of a government owned highway, we now have a church to preach the crucified Christ, and the gospel of love.

No other agency would stand for such talk as, **“God LOVES YOU so much that He sent His only Son, Jesus Christ, to take your due punishment, and in return give you abundant and everlasting life.”**

We inaugurated the new church building in May 2017. Until now we have had four gospel campaigns and four conferences. The result was hundreds of people were saved. In December we shall hold our **Fifth GREAT CAMPAIGN FOR CHRIST** – as the Christmas crusade to close the year 2018. We hope to continue with these meetings in the next year (2019).

These meetings are costly. We invite you to participate in the Great Commission work in Tanzania by:-

- Your intercession that more people become receptive when they hear the good news of salvation
- Committing finances to pay for crusade meetings (advertisement public address equipment hire, transport and accommodation of preachers), mobile pulpit hire, printing of fliers and hand bills, allowances to personnel. We aim to reach people because we get news of troubles, problems, disasters and frustrations for which **JESUS IS THE ANSWER** to the voices from troubled hearts in this tormented generation.



In conclusion we once again appeal to the mighty Lord God to speak and touch your kind hearts to donate for our needs. We would very much appreciate to receive a communication and the item you select to sponsor fully or in part.
